

DL-1300 Lift Table

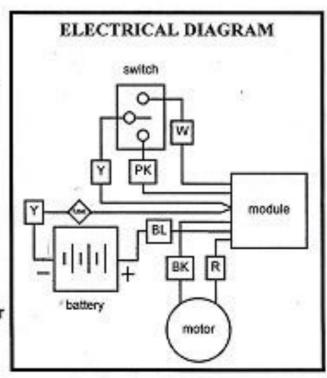


Operating and Safety Instructions

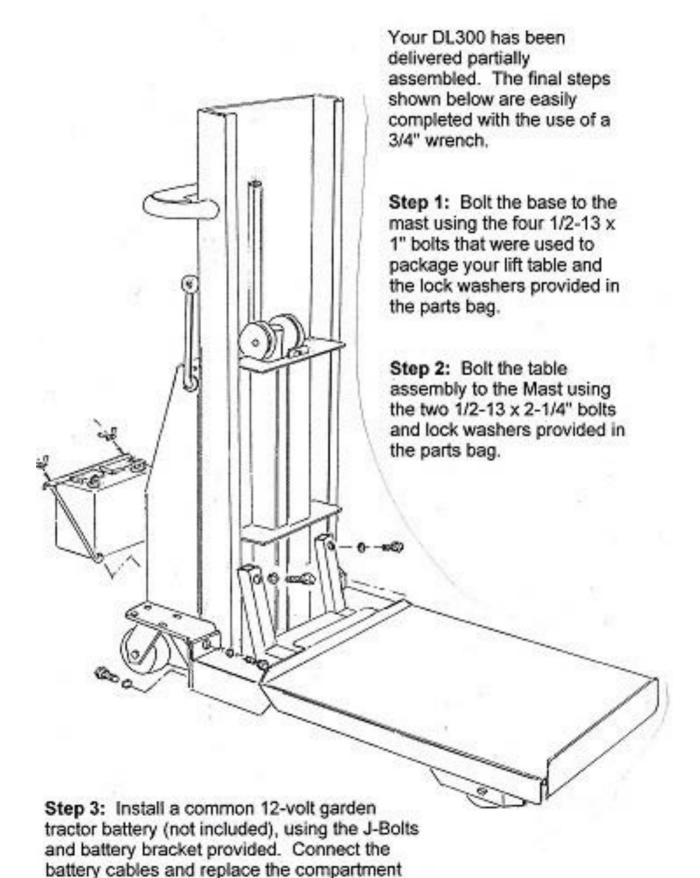
 Consider the appropriate lifting range for the task you will be performing and adjust the "dual-lifting" mechanism if necessary before attempting to load equipment on the table surface.



- If it is necessary to raise or lower equipment beyond the limits of any one lift range, transfer the load to a workbench temporarily in order to safely switch the "dual-lifting" mechanism to the other lift range. Then reload the table and continue operation.
- Make sure the brake is securely engaged any time the table is stationary. Sudden shifts could occur during raising or lowering of the table without the brake secured, causing injury or damage to equipment.
- Keep all bystanders clear of the lift whenever raising, lowering or transporting the lift under load.
- Always lower the lift table to the bottom of its lift travel before transporting to any other area.
- Do not attempt to operate this lift table on any ramp, incline or other uneven surface.
- Make sure all loads are placed squarely on the table surface. Unbalanced loads could fall or cause the table to overturn.
- Note the stated capacity of the DL300 Mobile Lift table you are operating as well as the weight of any components to be raised. Do not exceed the stated weight capacity limits.
- Be observant whenever the DL300 is in operation. Keep hands and feet clear of any moving parts to avoid potential injury.
- Be sure to clear any obstructions from the area under and around the lift before lowering the table to the floor.
